Dear Families and staff,

Updated Information Concerning Novel Coronavirus

On 29 February, there was an important addition to the measures that the Australian Government is taking to protect the community against novel coronavirus. While the threat to public health here in Australia continues to remain low, there is an increasing number of cases occurring worldwide. As such the Australian Government has now included a restriction on people travelling from Iran.

Based on this updated public health advice, we continue to ask that any children, parents or staff members returning from or transiting through mainland China or Iran are not to attend any of our Busy Bees Services for at least 14 days after leaving China or Iran. In addition, any child or staff member who has come into close contact with someone with a confirmed case of coronavirus also needs to self-isolate for a 14 day period.

The current public health advice is that during this period you should self-isolate at home. Being isolated at home means that you need to remain at home for the full period, except where medical assistance is required. Isolated persons cannot go to work, school or public areas for the full 14 day incubation period and visitors to the home should be discouraged.

Again, while the risk of exposure here in Australia remains relatively low, we believe this precautionary action is needed. The safety and wellbeing of the staff, children, and the wider community associated with our Services is paramount.

If you have any questions or concerns in relation to the above advice please speak with your Service Manager. If you have concerns you may have been exposed to the virus, the public health advice is to contact your GP immediately and self-isolate.
